Minnesota schools wrestle with mask decisions just weeks before classes start



Minnesota school leaders are spending the last precious weeks of summer break agonizing over a decision they'd hoped to avoid this year: whether to require everyone in school to wear masks.

As recently as a few weeks ago, many districts were on track to begin a school year that looked mostly like those of pre-pandemic times. But the surge in COVID-19 cases fueled by the virus' delta variant halted some of those plans.

Minnesota public transit benefits under infrastructure bill

Public transportation systems across Minnesota could get \$856 million under the \$1 trillion bipartisan infrastructure bill approved by the U.S. Senate last month.

That infusion over the next five years could prove transformative to transit service across the state, said Nuria Fernandez, administrator of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), during a visit Tuesday to the Twin Cities.

Minnesota State Fair breaks 100K visitors Saturday; attendance still down overall



The Minnesota State Fair started to rebound from a stormy first couple of days on Saturday, but attendance was still much lower than in recent years.

Day 3 saw 129,984 visitors pass through the gates, the first time the Great Minnesota Get-Together surpassed 100,000 this year — the fair only dipped below 100,000 once during its last running in 2019. Saturday's mark was a 38% decline from the same day in 2019, when 209,105 people congregated at the fairgrounds.

The Minnesota Department of Health will provide free COVID-19 testing at the site of the former DMV location, 9930 Logan Avenue, in Bloomington. The site will open on Monday, August 30 at 11 a.m. Saliva testing will be offered Monday through Friday, 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Testing is free at all of the state's community testing sites. Participants will be asked for their health insurance information so the state can bill their insurance company on their behalf. If a person is uninsured or if insurance doesn't cover some or all of the cost, the state will cover the difference so testing remains open to all at no cost.


